Code of Conduct

- 1. **All are welcome and respected.** Fair and kind treatment of any individual within the center is expected. We do not discriminate based on sex, race, age, ability, marital status, ethnicity, religion, or sexual orientation.
- 2. **Be a good relative.** This community center is a shared space with shared resources, be courteous of other's property and a good steward of this facility. Do not steal, intentionally damage, dirty, and/or destroy property.
- 3. **Behave appropriately.** Avoid dangerous, offensive, or harassing actions, language, dress, and topics. Do not discuss religion and/or politics.
- 4. **No solicitation.** Solicitation of any kind is not permitted without prior approval from the site director.
- 5. **This is a sober space.** Smoke only in designated outside areas, otherwise use or being under the influence of alcohol and/or other drugs inside the space is prohibited.
- 6. **Avoid Conflict.** WCHS has a strict zero tolerance policy regarding violence. Do not threaten or cause physical or mental harm towards anyone.

Any individuals not adhering to this code will be asked to leave and could be refused temporary or permanent access.
